

Baltimore City Medical Society: Leading the Way, Past, Present and Future

- Dr. Charles Wiesenthal, the "father" of medical education in Baltimore, assumed presidency of the first local medical society, predecessor to Baltimore City Medical Society, in 1788.
- BCMS challenged the patent medicine industry, demanding ingredients be placed on product labels. BCMS advocated for pure drinking water for City residents and for a public ambulance service in the City.
- Full BCMS membership was granted to Black physicians in 1949. Dr. Roland Smoot became the first Black President in 1978.
- BCMS Foundation was established as an affiliate of BCMS, to provide charitable and educational endeavors in Baltimore City.
- BCMS developed "Doctors' Day in Annapolis," which later became an annual statewide program.
- BCMS established a Mini Internship for legislators to shadow physicians to gain a better understanding of the provision of health care.
- BCMS commemorated its 100th Anniversary as a component of MedChi, with the publication of a commissioned book on its illustrious history; the event also included a successful silent auction, with proceeds supporting the BCMS Foundation.
- BCMS authored important resolutions for consideration by the American Medical Association, including a prohibition on the sale of tobacco and tobacco-related products in businesses providing health care, and prohibiting non-compete clauses in physician employment contracts.
- BCMS offered a series of continuing medical education sessions on medical marijuana and patient care, and physician well-being.
- BCMS developed several resource guides: "Red Flags: Tips for Your Practice" and "Senior Resource Guide: To Assist Physicians with Patient Care."
- BCMS will present its inaugural "Physicians Leading Physicians to Financial Independence," a "must attend" for physicians, residents, and students, on September 9, 2023.
- BCMS presented "The Future of Medical Education," featuring the Deans of University of Maryland School of Medicine and The Johns Hopkins School of Medicine in 2003. A program is being planned for later this year.

Kavita B. Kalra, M.D., an oncologist and hematologist with offices in Baltimore City, took the presidential reigns of Baltimore City Medical Society for 2020. She also serves as the Division Head of Hematology/Oncology at the University of Maryland Midtown Campus and is on the board of Maryland and DC Society of Clinical Oncology. Dr. Kalra completed her Bachelors in Biochemistry from the University of Maryland College Park. She is a graduate of St. George's University Medical School. She completed her Residency in Internal Medicine at the University of Maryland Midtown Campus, and her Fellowship in Hematology/Oncology at the Greenebaum Cancer Center at the University of Maryland Medical Center. Dr. Kalra has been the recipient of several notable honors and awards, including The Patient's Choice Compassionate Award, a national program that honors the top 3% of U.S. physicians for their compassionate patient care.



Camellus Ezeugwu, M.D., Ph.D., FACP, FACC, FSCAI, a cardiologist and the Medical Director of the Just Heart Cardiovascular Group Inc., served as president of Baltimore City Medical Society for 2021 and 2022. Dr. Ezeugwu is a graduate of St. George's University School of Medicine and completed an Internship and Residency at Seton Hall University's Graduate Medical Program in New Jersey. He completed a Fellowship in Critical Care Medicine at Mt. Sinai Hospital in New York, a Fellowship in Cardiology at State University of New York, Buffalo, and a Fellowship in Interventional Cardiology at The Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. Dr. Ezeugwu is current President of the Chesapeake IPA (CIPA) (a group of over 100 practices in Maryland) focused on the survival of independent practitioners in Maryland. Dr. Ezeugwu is the recipient of numerous awards and honors, including The Excellence Award, as "America's Top Cardiologists," given by the Consumers' Research Council, Washington, DC.



Ronald E. Delanois, M.D., F.A.A.O.S., is the 2023 President of the Baltimore City Medical Society. Dr. Delanois is a board-certified, fellowship-trained orthopedic surgeon who has more than 20 years of experience with complex hip, knee and shoulder reconstructive surgery. He serves as the Jerome P. Reichmister, M.D., Endowed Chairman of Orthopedics for the Rubin Institute for Advanced Orthopedics, the Division Director of the Center for Joint Preservation and Replacement, the Director of Hip, Knee, and Shoulder Surgery, and also the Director of the Research Division and Research Fellowship Program. Dr. Delanois is a graduate of the Uniformed Services University of the Health Sciences (USUHS). He then did his orthopedic training in the Air Force at Wilford Hall Medical Center in San Antonio, Texas, and completed a Fellowship in Hip and Knee Replacement Surgery at The Johns Hopkins Medical Institutions.


